That is only a four-week summer break, a drastic change of an 8 week vacation they enjoyed three years ago. The shorter schedule is a bittersweet situation for us at the home: bitter because four weeks goes awfully quick and sweet because our children need that school schedule structure. They perform well under a structured, planned out schedule and our school classrooms provide that daily routine. As of the writing of this newsletter we have not received our high school permit yet from the high school education department in Mexicali, but what we would like to present is a list of our 2017-18 teachers for the coming year to give you an idea of who we employ and what they do. Our school is highly recommended in our area and that is a result of the quality of staff and training they receive from Tina and other invited experts during the year. Keeping the quality of education at a high level at Colegio Santa Marta comes from not only the hard work from our teachers but also the quality of service that is offered. From the chart you can see that we offer many extra curricular classes. Our philosophy is that every child can learn. Some children do well sitting at their desks and listening to the teacher lecture, but most children learn by touching, sharing, interacting and doing as they collaborate on different projects. 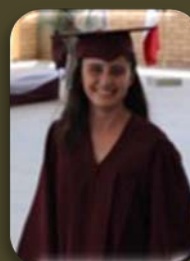
