## Guadalupe is home with the Lord

Guadalupe joined our staff three years ago. She was living in Tijuana with her two daughters, Luz, 13, and Lupita, 11, who has Down Syndrome. Guadalupe, as a single mother, was having trouble balancing her job and taking care of her two daughters while in Tijuana. Lupita was spending much of her time in their house by herself. Guadalupe was looking for a solution to her problem when one of our teachers, a relative of Guadalupe, mentioned our school and home for children. Guadalupe came for a visit and decided to leave Lupita under the care of Juanita in one of our girls' house. Three months passed and Guadalupe could not handle living without her daughter, Lupita.

They came back to the ranch asking if the whole family could stay together; Guadalupe working as a janitor at our school and her two daughters attending our school. We agreed and they settled into one of our small houses and adapted into the Santa Marta family. Guadalupe was a hard worker and while she was with us took on the jobs as a janitor, assistant cook in the cafeteria, and finally as a teacher's assistant in the primary special education classroom where she was able to teach her own daughter!

Guadalupe was diagnosed with the first signs of diabetes during her stay and was taking medication to help control her sugar levels. One day she was preparing for a school outing, she did not eat breakfast, was returning to feed Lupita and she fainted and fell hard on her head. She was rushed to the clinic but during the transport she passed away. Wow, what a shock for everyone at the ranch and our school staff. It happened so quickly we could hardly believe it was true. How could that be? Her biggest fear was leaving her two daughters alone and that's exactly what happened. It brought up those same feelings we had with Angelina and those same "why?" questions were being asked. We had a memorial service for her, and the children were sad but because of the experience we went through with Angelina there was more of a peace among them. We focused on the "for what purpose" questions. Guadalupe passed so we could testify to others about her kind and sensitive spirit, how she found the Lord here at the ranch, and how her three years at the ranch were her happiest ones. Her daughter Luz was challenged to continue in her mothers' footsteps to follow the Lord and show her kindness to others. Her death showed each one of us that our life is on a thread between life and death, and we do not know when we will die but to be always ready when He calls us home. Deny yourself and live for Him, this is what the Christian life is all about. Guadalupe's daughters are in the safe care of her brother who will move them to the interior of Mexico with their own family. Guadalupe and Angelina are our forever Santa Marta family and are truly missed by all but because of their lives and their loss of life we are stronger and have a closer relationship to our heavenly Father. ## Matching Grant



We have some good news since we wrote in our last newsletter on Valentina. We were able to see a nephrologist and they believe the results of the biopsy that was done on her kidney in Tijuana is Minimal Change Disease, which is one of the less severe diseases of the nephrotic syndrome realm. It is possible that her kidneys will go into remission as she physically matures, meaning no more steroids or edema flare ups. We also took her to an eye doctor, and she has no problems with her vision which rules out several different serious kidney syndromes. We continue to pursue cochlear implants (CI) and we have doctor appointments through July and August. It is our prayer that she will be selected for a bilateral cochlear implant surgery in September. We have been accepted to receive

Medi-cal insurance for her which will help with costs, but we are still uncertain if her policy will cover the full CI surgery. A special couple and friends of the ranch for many years have felt a special connection to Valentina's situation. They are offering to double any gift amount towards her surgery up to \$10,000. That would mean \$20,000 for her needs. Thank you and continue to pray that doors will open for Valentina to receive the CI and allow her to hear and to speak!! Please mark your gifts "Valentina".
